

WATER IS SOUTH AFRICA'S MOST PRECIOUS RESOURCE

- The garden has been deliberately landscaped with water wise plants that recognizes our Mediterranean climate hot, dry summers and wet winters. We therefore make use of predominantly indigineous plants including local fynbos that require less water.
- We make use of grey water irrigation by watering the gardens from shower, bath and basin water.
- The pool backwash water is recycled and pumped back into the pool after it has been treated this obviously means that we do not need to use municipal water for this.
- We ask our guests to assist us in conserving water by limiting the number of times their towels need to be replaced and their bed linen changed. Laundering of 2 sets of towels and a change in bed linen on a daily basis is obviously wasteful. Our guests get to decide.
