



## **WATER IS SOUTH AFRICA'S MOST PRECIOUS RESOURCE**

- The garden has been deliberately landscaped with water wise plants that recognizes our Mediterranean climate - hot, dry summers and wet winters. We therefore make use of predominantly indigenous plants including local fynbos that require less water.
- We make use of grey water irrigation by watering the gardens from shower, bath and basin water.
- The pool backwash water is recycled and pumped back into the pool after it has been treated – this obviously means that we do not need to use municipal water for this.
- We ask our guests to assist us in conserving water by limiting the number of times their towels need to be replaced and their bed linen changed. Laundering of 2 sets of towels and a change in bed linen on a daily basis is obviously wasteful. Our guests get to decide.
